Preparing for spring

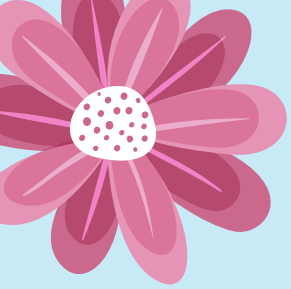
